LeGuin makes lavish use of alliteration, the repetition, at close intervals, of the initial consonant sounds as in bare bright or blinding biting, used to accentuate the poetry and the beauty of language, apart from the actual meaning of the words: "I felt a pang of pure pity for the man. LeGuin believes that order can be more effectively achieved through rituals and parades than by armies or police. He is called "Genry" by the Karhidiers, who have trouble pronouncing the letter "L".
