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During the reign of Tibetan Dharma King Trisong Detsen the Tibetan masters refined their already well-developed arts through research and studies of different country's tradition. Art objects, therefore, must follow rules specified in the Buddhist scriptures regarding proportions, Tibetan Religious Art, color, stance, hand positions, and attributes in order to personify correctly the Buddha or Deities.

A group of murals in Jokhang Temple shows people singing, dancing, playing music. Other traditions of Buddhist scroll paintings are not usually covered by the term Tibetan Religious Art, although they may have many similarities, and descend from the same origins. But we do know that the intent of the artist was to convey iconographic information. In the example at left the flanking bodhisattvas are in a style, one of several found in such figures in this period, that appears derived from central Indian art.

Tibetan Religious Art treated, thangka can last a long time, but because of they have been known to sew mountings with a window so small that it covers important iconographic and aesthetically relevant sections of the painting composition. Most works are done anonymously.
